I know it is late and almost Christmas Eve, but Jenny is not doing well in the mental section of the jail. I have no idea as to why she is in the jail and was not transferred to Harris County Psychiatric Center. She is being held as a prisoner and she is a victim.

She is not going to be a good witness for you all if she stays there. She is not taking her same medication nor does she have the support of anyone. At least at HCPC, she can have physical contact and not talked through pexi glass like jail. She told me [REDACTED] last time I spoke to her so obviously she is unstable still. She has a list of medication. I am unsure as to why she only had a resperadol shot and ambien. The drugs are not enough for someone with bipolar disorder.

Please keep me in the loop when it comes to Jennifer. I know you want her to testify, but this way is not going to work. It is Christmas and here we are with Jennifer unable to have physical contact with her. She should have more privileges like being able to call when she needs to, that is just how Jennifer works. Right now, she is like a caged animal ready to explode.

Nicolas, I do hope you are feeling better.
