The next step is I have to talk to the doctor and he has to determine what's best for her. The end decision of where to transfer her is up to her doctor. Even though they are not yet allowed to talk to me about her treatment, they have heard me talk about her situation. Everyone understands the situation so hopefully that will not be a problem. My only worry is that this is going to fall during new year's, delaying it more. But I have been keeping up with the staff to get it moved as fast as possible.

I don't see where she was assigned a victim witness caseworker. The 2 people I usually deal with it are out on vacation. If you want to call them, their number is 713-274-0250. The other option is waiting until the 4th when I know everyone is back and I will walk over there and meet with them, explain things, and have them call you. If you call just have Jenny's info and the case #'s ready.

I am very worried about Jenny's mental health and I know about the danger she can be to herself. While I appreciate Landon a lot, he was not able to ensure her safety to me. His solution was to let her go off on her own and she would come back when she was ready. That didn't sit well with me, especially knowing about her last suicide attempt, which partially led to all this. I will do absolutely everything in my power to make sure she gets the help she needs and all assistance available now and more importantly after this trial.
