

Appointments I am the former Republican County Chairman in Fort Bend County having resigned in March to allow the next generation to start leading. As chairman, I worked with David on the appointments of Maggie Jaramillo, David Perwin and Chad Bridges. I stayed within the bounds of my function and did not actively advocate for any candidate. I simply determined the voting history of the candidates and my assessment of re-electability after appointment.

Now, since I no longer have the chair position, I will advocate for two candidates, Ken Cannata for the new district court and Judge Jim Shoemake for Administrative Judge.

Ken has been the JP in Fort Bend Precinct 3 for 11 years and in private practice for many others. His case work will stand up favorable against anyone currently applying. He has work tirelessly with the Katy ISD and the county to handle truancy cases in a more effective manner and one in which children would not permanently be hurt by immature actions. I cannot provide a higher recommendation for a candidate! He has shown great judicial acumen and behavior, is involved in his community and holds himself to a higher standard than those coming before him.


Since taking the bench as a Justice of the Peace, Ken has developed a reputation for fairness, courtesy and a common sense approach to the day-to-day operation of his court.

She also works cooperatively with her peers; she is kind and fosters good relations with all those around her.

I originally met Ms. Chiang through the Fort Bend Junior Service League in the spring of 2015. And she could have not come, for me at least, with any better timing given my, at that point, decision to transition my career from tax to law. To be frank, she was one of my first friends in Fort Bend County, as I had recently moved from Montgomery County to Fort Bend County, and knew very few people. I could not have asked for a better first friend in Fort Bend County. Mrs. Chiang represents what Fort Bend County is known for: friendly, yet business-oriented.

What I recognized immediately was Ms. Chiang's active involvement in the community. Not only did she communicate well and effectively the tasks at hand, but executed them. We found ourselves crossing paths again and again in the community – eventually both involved in the Wills for Heroes program, where local attorneys provide estate planning packages for policemen, fireman, and first responders. And more than that, she demonstrated creativity, with no lack of thinking outside the norm for a solution where appropriate and logical.

Further, Ms. Chiang is fearless in all the right areas, not afraid to dip her toes in the local and state political arena, by being the Precinct Chair and Secretary of the Republican Party of Fort Bend County. She has been active in her community at the political level, yet careful and mindful of the short-term and long-term implications of such involvement. She does not take politics, or positions of leadership for that matter, lightly. Overall, I saw no tension, but rather good relations, with all of her peers, and I saw her contributing effectively, and beyond, to the community, dedicated to completion of each of the tasks before her and to building up not only herself but those around her. I could not anticipate from my experience with Mrs. Chiang that she will fail to succeed at the highest level in all of her career endeavors.
